

Baayu Customer Privacy Policy

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Introduction

Your privacy matters to Bikozee Ecotech Private Limited (the "Company", "we", "Baayu", or "us"). This Privacy Policy ("Policy") describes how we collect, use, disclose, and protect your personal information when you use our website located at [Baayu.in](#), the Baayu mobile application, or access any of our Services (collectively, "Baayu Platform" or "Services").

The terms "you" and "your" refer to users of the Baayu Platform. By using the Baayu Platform and Services, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to the collection, transfer, use, storage, disclosure, and sharing of your information as described in this Policy.

This Policy is part of and incorporated within, and is to be read along with, the applicable Terms and Conditions. If you do not agree with this Policy, please do not use or access the Baayu Platform.

If you have questions about this Privacy Policy, please contact us through the email address or portal provided on our website and/or Mobile Application.

1. Definitions

Unless otherwise provided in this Privacy Policy, the terms capitalized shall have the following meanings:

"Baayu Platform" means the Baayu website at [Baayu.in](#) and the Baayu mobile applications available on iOS and Android devices, through which Services are offered.

"Services" means any transportation, travel booking, delivery, or related mobility services offered by Baayu through the Platform.

"Customer" means a person who uses the Baayu Platform to request or receive Services.

"Driver Partner" means independent third-party vehicle operators or service providers who offer services through the Baayu Platform.

"Personal Data" means any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual, including name, contact details, location, financial information, and usage patterns.

"Sensitive Personal Data" means categories of information including government-issued ID numbers, financial data, health

information, biometric data, and other information classified as sensitive under applicable Indian laws.

"Processing" means any operation performed on Personal Data, including collection, recording, organization, structuring, storage, adaptation, modification, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure, transfer, erasure, or destruction.

"Data Fiduciary" means Baayu, as the entity that determines the purposes and means of processing Personal Data.

"Data Processor" means third-party service providers acting on behalf of Baayu in processing Personal Data.

"Device" means any computer, mobile device, smartphone, tablet, or other device used to access the Baayu Platform.

"Device Identifier" means unique identifiers such as IP address, device ID, IMEI, or similar identifiers automatically assigned to your Device.

"Usage Information" means information collected about how you interact with the Baayu Platform, including browsing history, features accessed, time spent, and transaction patterns.

"Co-Branded Services" means services offered in partnership with third-party providers where data may be jointly processed.

"Promotion" means any contests, sweepstakes, or promotional offers extended by Baayu or third parties.

2. What Information Do We Collect?

2.1 Information You Provide to Us

2.1.1 Account Registration and Profile Data

When you create a Baayu account, we collect:

- Full legal name as per government-issued identification
- Email address
- Mobile phone number (primary and alternate)
- Residential address (current and permanent if different)
- Date of birth and gender identity
- Profile photograph (optional)
- Username and password (encrypted)
- Emergency contact information
- Payment method details (card, UPI, wallet IDs)

2.1.2 Communication and Support Data

- Messages and calls with Baayu customer support
- Problem reports and troubleshooting details
- Feedback, ratings, and reviews you provide
- Survey responses and promotional preferences
- Content shared in in-app chat with Driver Partners

2.1.3 Transaction and Trip Data

- Pickup and drop-off locations and addresses
- Scheduled trip times and actual travel times
- Trip distance, duration, and route
- Fare details, payment method, and receipt information
- Cancellation details and reasons
- Any special requests or preferences noted

2.1.4 Verification and Identity Data

- Government-issued identification (Aadhaar, Voter ID, Passport, etc.)
- Address proof documents (if required for verification)
- Background verification results (if applicable)
- Identity verification status and related documents

2.1.5 Marketing and Preference Data

- Preferences for service types and promotional communications
- Languages and communication channels you prefer
- Accessibility requirements or special needs
- Participation in referral programs or contests
- Consent records for marketing and data processing

2.2 Information Collected Automatically as You Use Services

2.2.1 Location Data

For Customers:

- Precise GPS location when you request a service or open the app
- Location data collected from time a service is requested until completion
- Approximate location when precise GPS is unavailable or disabled
- Historical location patterns and frequently visited locations
- Location shared with Driver Partners during active trips

Note: You can control location sharing through device settings. However, disabling location may limit service functionality.

2.2.2 Device and Technical Information

- Device type, model, and manufacturer
- Operating system version and device settings
- Mobile app version and updates installed
- IP address and mobile network information
- Device identifiers (IMEI, Android ID, IDFA)
- Browser type and version (for web users)
- Device memory, storage, and technical specifications

2.2.3 Usage and Activity Information

- How frequently you use the Platform
- Features you access and time spent on each
- Bookings made, services requested, and patterns
- Search queries and service filters used
- Rate of trip acceptance and cancellations
- Time of day and frequency of service usage
- Interaction with in-app content and promotions
- Pages or sections visited on the website

2.2.4 Analytics and Crash Data

- App crashes, errors, and technical issues
- System logs and diagnostic information
- Performance metrics and platform responsiveness
- Analytics data on feature usage and user behaviour
- Session duration and user flow patterns

2.2.5 Cookies and Similar Technologies

What We Use:

- Session cookies (temporary, deleted when you log out)
- Persistent cookies (stored on your device until expiration or deletion)
- Web beacons and tracking pixels

Local storage and similar client-side storage technologies

Mobile SDKs for analytics and functionality

Purposes:

Authentication and account security

Remembering preferences and login information

Tracking usage patterns for analytics

Personalizing your experience

Preventing fraud

Measuring effectiveness of marketing campaigns

Your Control: You can disable cookies through browser or device settings, though this may limit app functionality.

2.3 Information from Third Parties

2.3.1 Payment and Financial Partners

Payment authorization and transaction status from payment gateways Card verification and fraud check results Bank details validation for refunds or payouts

2.3.2 Third-Party Service Providers

2.3.3 Other Users

Reviews and ratings provided by Driver Partners about you Feedback or complaints from other users

2.3.4 External Data Sources

2.4 Information Collected by Mobile Application

2.4.1 Mobile Device Information

When you use the Baayu mobile app, we automatically collect:

Device manufacturer and model Operating system type and version Device screen resolution and display settings

Preferred language and region settings Mobile internet browser type Installation and update status

2.4.2 App Usage and Interaction Data

Features accessed within the app

Frequency and duration of app usage

Search queries and filter selections

2.4.3 Communication and SMS Data

passwords (OTP) and authentication codes sent to your phone SMS based verification records

Call logs with Baayu support (metadata—duration, timestamp) Message timestamps and communication frequency

Important: We do not store the content of SMS messages or voice calls between you and Driver Partners, only metadata for verification and service purposes.

3. Use of Information Collected

3.1 Service Delivery and Account Management

We use your information to:

Create, maintain, and manage your Baayu account

- Process your requests for transportation, delivery, or travel services
- Match you with appropriate Driver Partners based on location, preferences, and service type
- Enable real-time tracking of your service provider
- Calculate and process trip fares and charges
- Generate receipts, invoices, and transaction records
- Provide customer support and resolve complaints

3.2 Payment Processing and Financial Management

- Process payments through your chosen payment method
- Handle refunds, disputes, and chargebacks
- Issue invoices and payment receipts
- Manage promotional credits, vouchers, and discounts
- Calculate taxes and fulfil regulatory requirements
- Maintain transaction history for your records

3.3 Communication and Notifications

- Send trip confirmation messages and service updates
- Notify you of Driver Partner arrival and pickup details
- Provide safety alerts and emergency communications
- Send account-related notifications (password resets, security alerts)
- Update you on policy changes or service interruptions
- Communicate promotional offers and discounts (with your consent)

3.4 Safety, Security, and Fraud Prevention

- Verify your identity and account authenticity
- Detect and prevent fraudulent transactions or accounts
- Monitor for suspicious activity or policy violations
- Investigate accidents, complaints, or safety incidents
- Share safety information with Driver Partners to protect all users
- Enable emergency features and safety protocols
- Comply with safety and regulatory requirements

3.5 Platform Improvement and Analytics

- Analyze usage patterns to improve service features
- Develop new features and services based on demand
- Test and optimize the Platform's performance
- Understand geographic demand for services
- Improve matching algorithms and pricing models
- Enhance user experience through personalization
- Conduct market research and trend analysis

3.6 Personalization and Recommendations

- Provide personalized service suggestions and offers
- Customize the app interface based on your preferences
- Recommend popular routes or Driver Partner types
- Suggest services or promotions aligned with your history
- Remember saved locations and frequent trip destinations

3.7 Marketing and Promotional Communications

- Send promotional emails, SMS, or push notifications about Baayu services
- Notify you of special offers, referral bonuses, or contests

- Share updates about new features or service expansions
- Conduct market surveys or feedback collection
- Inform you of partnership offers or co-branded services

Important: You can opt out of promotional communications at any time through app settings or by unsubscribing from emails.

3.8 Legal and Regulatory Compliance

- Comply with taxation requirements and regulatory filings
- Maintain records as mandated by law or regulatory bodies
- Respond to government, law enforcement, or court requests
- Investigate suspected violations of our Terms and Conditions
- Protect Baayu's legal rights and defend against claims
- Meet industry-specific regulatory requirements

3.9 What We Do NOT Use Your Data For

- We do not sell your Personal Data to third parties for their marketing purposes
- We do not use your data for targeted advertising without consent
- We do not share your data with unrelated third parties for their business purposes

4. Core Automated Processes

4.1 Matching Algorithm

How It Works:

When you request a service, our automated matching system evaluates:

- Your location and the requested destination
- Available Driver Partners and their current location
- Estimated time of arrival and trip duration
- Your preferences (if any specified)
- Driver Partner ratings and availability
- Historical patterns and demand forecasting
- Service type compatibility (vehicle category, accessibility)

The algorithm automatically assigns a Driver Partner and communicates the booking to them.

What This Means for You:

You may receive service requests from different Driver Partners based on real-time availability. Your chances of being matched depend on location, time, and Driver Partner availability. The algorithm aims to match you efficiently but may not always select the geographically closest option.

Your Rights:

- You can view the assigned Driver Partner's details before confirming
- You can cancel and request a different match if needed
- You can appeal if you believe a matching decision was unfair

4.2 Dynamic Pricing

How It Works:

Our pricing algorithm automatically calculates trip fares based on:

- Base fare for the service type
- Distance and estimated duration of the trip
- Real-time traffic conditions
- Current demand and supply ratio (surge pricing)
- Time of day or special circumstances

Promotional discounts or incentives you're eligible for
Applicable taxes and service fees

What This Means for You:

Fares may vary based on real-time factors and time of booking
Higher fares during peak demand times (surge pricing)
You receive an upfront fare estimate before confirming the service

Transparency:

Fare breakdown is provided showing all components
You can view historical pricing data through your account
Any surge pricing is clearly indicated before booking

4.3 Fraud Detection and Prevention

How It Works:

Automated systems monitor your account for:

Unusual login patterns or access from new devices
Abnormal transaction amounts or frequency
Repeated cancellations or suspicious behaviour
Payment methods that don't match your profile
Coordinated activity suggesting multiple fraudulent accounts
Reports from Driver Partners about suspicious behaviour

What This Means for You:

Your account may be temporarily restricted if suspicious activity is detected
You may be asked to verify your identity or confirm transactions
We may investigate unusual patterns to protect both you and Driver Partners

Your Rights:

You will be notified of any account restrictions
You can contest suspected fraudulent activity
You have the right to explain any flagged transactions

4.4 Performance and Reputation Scoring

How It Works:

While primarily applicable to Driver Partners, your performance as a Customer is also evaluated based on:

On-time confirmations and trip starts
Cancellation patterns and reasons
Behaviour during trips (as reported by Driver Partners)
Rating and feedback from Driver Partners
Compliance with Platform policies

What This Means for You:

Consistent cancellations or problematic behaviour may affect your service quality You may receive communications about improving service behaviour
Serious violations may result in account warnings or suspension

Fairness:

Performance metrics are averaged over time
You can view feedback provided by Driver Partners
You have the right to contest inaccurate information

4.5 Recommendation Engine

How It Works:

We use machine learning to:

- Analyze your booking history and preferences
- Predict services you may be interested in
- Recommend promotions relevant to your usage patterns
- Suggest new features or services

Your Control:

- You can adjust recommendation preferences in settings
- You can opt out of personalized recommendations
- Recommendations are always optional

5. Data Sharing and Disclosure

5.1 Sharing with Driver Partners

When you request a service, we share the following information with the assigned Driver Partner:

- Your first name (or a nickname if you choose to use one)
- Your mobile phone number (for trip coordination)
- Pickup location address
- Drop-off location address (if applicable)
- Any special instructions or requests you've noted
- Your rating and number of completed trips (to build trust)
- Your profile picture (if provided)
- Real-time location during the trip

Purpose: Enabling the Driver Partner to locate you, complete your service request, and maintain communication about the trip.

Your Privacy: Driver Partners are contractually bound to use this information only for providing the service and are prohibited from using it for any other purpose.

5.2 Sharing with Payment Processors and Financial Institutions

We share with payment partners:

- Card reference numbers (tokenized, not full card details)
- Transaction amounts and dates
- Billing address and name
- Payment status and authorization codes

Purpose: Processing payments securely and handling refunds.

Protection: Payment processors are PCI-DSS compliant and bound by strict confidentiality agreements.

5.3 Sharing with Analytics and Technology Partners

We may share with:

- Analytics providers (Google Analytics, Mixpanel, etc.)
- Cloud hosting and infrastructure providers (AWS, Google Cloud)
- Performance monitoring and error tracking services
- Mapping and location services (Google Maps, MapMyIndia)

Data Shared: Aggregated usage patterns, device information, location data (anonymized), app performance metrics.

Protection: All third parties are contractually obligated to protect data and comply with Indian data protection laws.

5.4 Sharing with Affiliates and Group Companies

For operational, compliance, or service enhancement purposes, we may share:

- Account and trip information with Baayu subsidiaries or affiliated entities

Aggregated usage data for business intelligence

Information necessary to provide coordinated services

5.5 Sharing for Safety and Compliance

We may disclose your information to:

Law enforcement or government agencies when required by law or legal process

Courts or regulatory bodies in response to lawful requests

Insurance companies for claims related to trips

Emergency services if you use emergency features in the app

Circumstances:

Valid legal orders, subpoenas, or warrants

Investigations of alleged criminal activity

Protection of public safety

Preventing imminent harm

5.6 Sharing with Co-Branded Service Partners

If you elect to use services offered through partnerships (e.g., credit-based booking, partner discounts), your information may be shared with those partners for:

Processing the co-branded service

Verifying your eligibility

Fulfilling the terms of the partnership

Important: You will be informed of data sharing for co-branded services before participating, and the partner's privacy policy will govern their use of your data.

5.7 Sharing During Business Changes

In the event of a merger, acquisition, asset sale, or significant corporate restructuring:

We may transfer your Personal Data to the successor entity

The successor entity will be bound by equivalent data protection obligations

You will be notified of any material changes to data handling practices

6. Third-Party Content and Links

6.1 Third-Party Services and Websites

The Baayu Platform may link to or integrate with third-party services, including:

Mapping services (Google Maps, MapMyIndia)

Payment platforms

Social media platforms

Insurance or verification providers

Partner booking or promotional platforms

6.2 Your Privacy on Third-Party Platforms

Important: Baayu does not control the privacy practices of these third parties. When you access external links:

You are subject to that third party's privacy policy

Any data you provide to them is governed by their terms

Baayu is not responsible for their data handling practices

We encourage you to review the privacy policies of any third-party service before sharing your information.

6.3 Social Media Features

Our Platform may include social media buttons (Facebook, WhatsApp, Twitter, etc.) for sharing content. These features may:

Set their own cookies on your device

Track your activity across websites

Collect information about your interactions
These are governed by the social platform's privacy policy, not ours.

7. Data Security

7.1 Technical Security Measures

7.1.1 Encryption

In Transit: All data transmitted between your device and our servers is encrypted using TLS (Transport Layer Security) encryption, typically 256-bit

At Rest: Sensitive data stored in our databases is encrypted using strong algorithms (AES-256 or equivalent)

Payment Data: Payment information is encrypted and tokenized; we do not store full credit card details

7.1.2 Access Controls

Role-based access control (RBAC) limiting employee access to necessary data

Multi-factor authentication for administrative access

Regular verification of user permissions and access rights

Immediate revocation of access for departing employees

7.1.3 Network Security

Communication Content: The notification will include information about the breach, affected data, potential risks, and recommended protective measures

Transparency: We will maintain a breach notification log and provide updates as the situation evolves

7.4 Limitations on Security

Important: While we implement strong security measures, no system is completely impenetrable. We cannot guarantee absolute security against all threats. Your responsibility includes:

- Maintaining the confidentiality of your password and login credentials
- Using strong, unique passwords
- Not sharing your account with others
- Keeping your device secure and updated
- Reporting suspicious activity immediately

8.1 Right to Access

You have the right to access your Personal Data held by

Baayu. What You Can Access:

- Your account profile and registered information
- Trip history and booking records
- Payment and transaction history
- Communications with customer support
- Your rating, feedback, and reviews
- All data we have collected about you

How to Request:

By submitting a formal data access request

Response Time: We will provide your data within 30 days of verification. **Format:** Data will be provided in a commonly used format (CSV, JSON, or PDF).

8.2 Right to Correction

You have the right to correct inaccurate or incomplete

information. What Can Be Corrected:

- Name and contact information

Residential address
Email address
Phone number
Payment method details
Profile information

How to Correct:

Directly through the app: Edit Profile, Account Settings
By contacting customer support: info@baayu.in
By submitting a correction request with supporting documentation

Response Time: We aim to correct information within 7 days.

Verification: For security reasons, certain corrections may require identity verification.

8.3 Right to Data Portability

You have the right to receive your data in a structured, commonly used format. How to Request:

Through app: Settings > Privacy > Export My Data
By emailing: info@baayu.in with "Data Portability Request"

What You'll Receive:

Account and profile data
Trip and booking history
Payment transaction records
Rating and feedback data
Communication records

Format: CSV, JSON, or another machine-readable format of your choice.

Response Time: Within 45 days of request.

8.4 Right to Erasure (Right to Be Forgotten)

You have the right to request deletion of your Personal Data.

Grounds for Deletion:

You withdraw consent previously given for processing
Data is no longer necessary for the original purpose
You object to processing and there are no overriding legitimate grounds
Data has been unlawfully processed
Legal obligation requires deletion

How to Request:

Follow the confirmation steps
You will receive email confirmation of the deletion request

Processing:

Upon receiving your deletion request, we send an email acknowledgment confirming receipt and informing you that your request is under process

We verify your identity by confirming the email address on file

We check your account for any outstanding dues, pending complaints, or unresolved grievances

If Outstanding Issues Exist: We contact you via email with details of the pending matters and instructions for resolution

If Account is Clear: We delete your data within 30 days of the verified request

You will receive a final email confirmation upon successful deletion

Limitations:

We may retain certain data beyond deletion for:

Legal compliance (tax records, regulatory filings): Typically 7 years

Pending or ongoing legal proceedings: Until resolution plus applicable statute of limitations

Outstanding financial obligations: Until full settlement

Fraud prevention and security: As necessary for ongoing investigations

Backup systems: Up to 6 months, then permanently deleted

Partial Deletion:

If full deletion is not possible due to legal retention obligations:

We delete all non-required data

Retained data is isolated from routine processing

Access is restricted to authorized personnel only

Retained data is deleted as soon as legally permissible

Important: After deletion, you will not be able to access your account, trip history, or recover your data. You will need to re-register if you wish to use Baayu services in the future.

8.5 Right to Restrict Processing

You have the right to request restriction of processing in certain circumstances.

Situations Where Restriction Applies:

You contest the accuracy of your data while we verify

Processing is unlawful, but you prefer restriction over deletion

We no longer need the data but you require it for legal claims

You have objected to processing pending verification of overriding grounds

How to Request:

Subject: "Request for Restriction of Processing"

Include: Full details of the restriction requested and grounds

Effect:

We will store your data but limit its processing

Exception: Processing may continue with your consent, for legal claims, or to protect others

Response Time: Within 30 days of request.

8.6 Right to Object

You have the right to object to processing of your Personal Data in certain circumstances.

8.6.1 Right to Opt Out of Marketing Communications

You may unsubscribe from promotional emails, SMS, or push notifications at any time

Via App: Settings > Notifications > Uncheck "Marketing Communications"

Via Email: Click the "Unsubscribe" link at the bottom of promotional emails

Via SMS: Reply "STOP" to SMS promotions

Direct Contact: Email info@baayu.in with "Opt Out" request

Response Time: Immediate for app settings; up to 48 hours for email/SMS opt-outs.

8.7 Right to Withdraw Consent

Where we process your data based on consent, you may withdraw that consent at any time.

Withdrawal Methods:

Through the app: Settings > Privacy > Manage Consents

By phone: Contact our Grievance Officer

Effect:

Withdrawal takes effect immediately

Does not affect lawfulness of processing before withdrawal

Other processing based on different legal grounds may continue

Some services may become unavailable without certain consents

Examples of Consentable Processing:

Marketing and promotional communications

Personalized recommendations

Location tracking beyond what's necessary for current trip

Behavioral analytics

8.8 Right to Lodge a Complaint

9. Location Data and Tracking

9.1 How We Collect Location Data

Precise Location (GPS):

Collected when you request a service or open the Baayu app

Accuracy typically 5-50 meters

Collected continuously during an active trip

Approximate Location:

Cell tower triangulation or Wi-Fi-based positioning

Used when precise GPS is unavailable

Accuracy 100-1000 meters

Location History:

Aggregated record of locations over time

Trip routes and patterns

Frequently visited areas

9.2 When We Collect Location Data

While App is Active (Foreground):

Continuously while using the app

During active trips from confirmation to completion

While App is in Background:

Only if you have granted "Always Allow" location permission
